- Former SAAF base (WWII era, operated Lockheed Venturas)
- ~13 km NE of Durbanville
- Circuit restricted to 2.5 NM radius, all turns LEFT
- Departure: Maintain 1500 ft ALT until 5 NM, call outbound on 131.10
- Transit: Avoid overflying, maintain 2000 ft ALT from 5 NM until past field
